






BLS ASE Fixed Location Platform



BLS Enforcement Summons

(Back of Summons)

This Summons is in accordance with Code of Virginia 46.2-882.1 & Smyth County Local Ordinance 44-171: The operator of a vehicle shall be liable for a monetary civil penalty imposed pursuant to this section if such vehicle is found, as evidenced by information obtained from a photo speed monitoring device, to be traveling at speeds of at least 12 miles per hour above the posted school crossing zone or highway work zone.

This summons is NOT considered a moving violation. Payment of the Civil Monetary Penalty amount of the violation will NOT result in points and cannot be used to increase your insurance rates. This violation is deemed NONCRIMINAL and will not be made a part of your driving record.

WARNING: Failure to pay the Civil Monetary Penalty will result in the one of the following:

- If the summons is issued to a vehicle registered in the commonwealth and is not paid by the due date, the owner will be required to APPEAR IN COURT.
- 2. If the summons is issued to an owner, lessee, or renter of a vehicle with a registration outside the commonwealth & such person fails to pay by the due date set out of in the summons or file, in a timely manner, a request for a court date or an Affidavit of Rebuttal, the summons will be eligible for all legal collection activities.

Any prosecution under this section shall be instituted & conducted in the same manner as prosecutions for traffic infractions.

CONTESTING THE TICKET: C.O.V. 46.2-882.1 You have the right to contest the Summons by timely requesting a court date. You must submit that request in writing within 30 days of the issue date on the front of this summons.

HOW TO CONTEST THE TICKET: Visit www.violationpayment.net. Click on the "Contest Your Citation" button. Follow the directions to print out the Hearing Request Form. Mail, fax, or email the form to the location as specified on the form. Once the District Court Hearing Request form is received, you will be notified by the Clerk of the Court of your scheduled court date. If you do not have access to the internet or fax machine, please call 1-855-252-0086.

Note: A Court Fee of \$79 will be assessed to the case in addition to the original fine amount.

RETURNED CHECKS (NSF): All returned checks will be charged a penalty of \$25.00.

NOT DRIVING VEHICLE: C.O.V. 46.2-882.1 The person receiving this summons has the ability to rebut the presumption that they were the operator of the vehicle at the time of the alleged violation through the filing of an affidavit to the clerk of the General District Court of the County that they were not the operator of the vehicle at the time of the alleged violation and provides the name & address of the person who was operating the vehicle at the time of the alleged violation or (ii) testifies in open court, under oath, that they were not the operator of the vehicle at the time of the alleged violation and provides the name & address of the person who was operating the vehicle at the time of the alleged violation.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING SUCH AFFIDAVIT:

Visit <u>WWW.VIOLATIONPAYMENT.NET</u>. Click on "99" to download the Affidavit. Fill out the form and mail, fax, or email to the location specified on the form. *Be advised that this form must be notarized.*

Note: This Affidavit of Rubuttal is not a request for a hearing.

STOLEN VEHICLE OR TAG: Must present to the court/jurisdiction a certified copy of a police report showing that the vehicle had been reported to the police as stolen prior to the time of the alleged violation.




BLS Violation Approval Interface






Court Hearings & Process

As part of the turn-key solution, Blue Line provides the Court Liaison, who will coordinate directly with the local judiciary to establish court schedules for all locations, including locations, times, and the maximum number of hearings allowed per session. Once established, Blue Line will handle the receipt and processing of contest forms, scheduling violators for their court dates, and notifying violators of their court dates




Blue Line will prepare court packets for each contested citation and include the court docket, a copy of the citation, a violation information sheet, camera certification, and a self-test log of the camera. Once the hearing has been held, the court of jurisdiction must return the filled-out docket, at which time Blue Line will enter the decisions based on the docket; these include dismissals, fine reductions, and judgments of liability, which will be then used to notify the violator of the outcome and requirements.
