Chuckie Reid, Vice Mayor Town of Farmville; Urban Section Chair Lisa Lucas-Burke, Councilmember City of Portsmouth; City Section Chair Letty Hardi, Mayor City of Falls Church; and Town Section Chair Phil Miskovic, Manager Town of Crewe. The section chairs were elected during section meetings held earlier in the day.
